INTRODUCTION TO RIMS

The Rajendra Institute of Medical Sciences(RIMS) is a premier medical institute located at Ranchi, the capital of Jharkhand. The Institute is an autonomous body established in 2002 under an Act of Jharkhand state Assembly. The Institute started as Rajendra Medical College in the year 1960 and was named after Dr. Rajendra Prasad, the first President of India. The Medical College Hospital came into existence in February 1965 and has excelled ever since. The Motto of the Institute is "Sarve Santu Niramaya". RIMS Ranchi has a very large and spacious campus. It has a 1500 bedded multi- speciality hospital with State of the Art equipment. The institute is a tertiary care centre that has the excellent infrastructure for patient care as well opportunity to acquire knowledge and skills from experienced faculties. The Institute also has a 100 bedded Trauma Centre, the first of its kind in Eastern India with most modern equipment. Under PMSSY scheme, a 240 bedded Super Specialty block was established to provide care for the patients in the field of Oncology, Cardiology, Urology, Paediatric Surgery and Cardio-thoracic Surgery. The Dental College, RIMS, Ranchi was founded in the year 2017 and is the first autonomous Dental College under Government of Jharkhand. RIMS conducts teaching programs in medical, dental and para-medical courses. Besides undergraduate courses, RIMS also offers post - graduate courses, PhD and super-specialty courses offered in various disciplines. RIMS also runs a College of Nursing and is affiliated to Ranchi University.

GRADE Introduction

The GRADE(Grading of Recommendations, Assessment, Development and Evaluation) approach was developed by the GRADE Working Group, a collaboration of methodologists, guideline developers, clinicians and other interested members, as a common, transparent and sensible method of grading the quality of evidence and the strength of recommendations in guidelines. This approach is being used by many international organizations to produce rigorous and transparent clinical practice guidelines and other health care recommendations. The Guideline development workshop is being conducted with the experts who have been founders of GRADE Working Group and associated with WHO guidelines development.

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP: From evidence to action

Facilitate the basic principles of guideline methodology, including how to critically appraise the evidence, grade the quality of the evidence, and move from evidence to recommendations by using GRADE.

- Become familiar with GRADE
- Create evidence profiles
- Understand EBM concepts

INTERNATIONALLY RENOWNED SPEAKERS

Dr. Gordan Guyatt

Dr. **Guyatt** is a Distinguished Professor in the Departments of Clinical Epidemiology & Biostatistics and Medicine at McMaster University in Hamilton, Ontario. He is known for his work on evidence based medicine, a term that he also coined. Dr.Gordon has published more than 1000 peer reviewed articles, including more than 140 in the leading journals of medicine (*NEJM, Lancet, BMJ, JAMA, PLoS Med and Ann Intern Med*), and his work has been cited more than 75,000 times. Dr.Gordon was named to the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame on 9th October 2015.



Dr. Bram Rochwerg

Dr. Rochwerg graduated from the University of Ottawa Medical School. He did his Internal Medicine Residency and Critical Care fellowship at McMaster. He also completed formal research training through the Masters of Health Research Methodology Program at McMaster. Dr. Rochwerg's main focus of research includes resuscitation medicine and intravenous fluids use in sepsis. He has gained knowledge and expertise in systematic reviews, meta-analysis and networking meta-analysis. His other area of focus is clinical practice guideline methodology and he currently works with many international organizations, like WHO, supporting their guideline development projects.
